6. Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice, and proclaimed to them, "You who are Jews, indeed all of you staying in Jerusalem. ...this is what was spoken through the prophet Joel: (Acts 2:14a,16b) **Hail Mary...**
7. 'It will come to pass in the last days,' God says, 'that I will pour out a portion of my spirit upon all flesh. Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy,' (Acts 2:17a). **Hail Mary...**
8. Therefore let the whole house of Israel know for certain that God has made him both Lord and Messiah, this Jesus whom you crucified." (Acts 2:36) **Hail Mary...**
9. Peter [said] to them, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the holy Spirit." (Acts 2:38) **Hail Mary...**
10. Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand persons were added that day. (Acts 2:41)
